Lies the essence of Scottish dance, sublime.

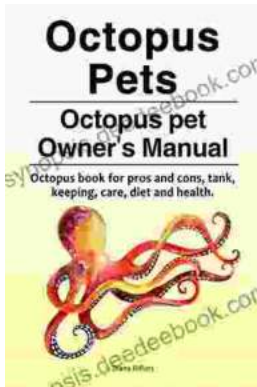

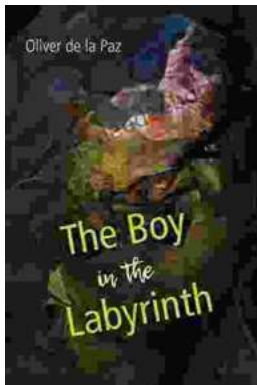
