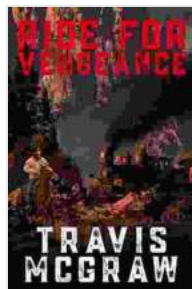


Casca: The Eternal Mercenary Travis McGraw

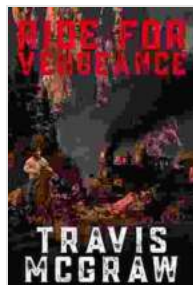

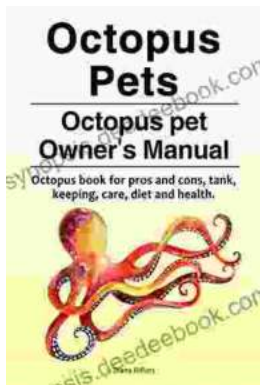
