

- "O mio babbino caro" from *Gianni Schicchi*
- "Un bel dì, vedremo" from *Madama Butterfly*
- "Nessun dorma" from *Turandot*
- "E lucevan le stelle" from *Tosca*
- "Va, pensiero" (Chorus of the Hebrew Slaves) from *Nabucco*

Musical Analysis

The medley opens with the haunting and tender melody of "O mio babbino caro," showcasing the lyrical and expressive capabilities of the flute. The oboe and clarinet then take center stage for "Un bel dì, vedremo," delivering a poignant and soaring rendition of Butterfly's aria.






