





SHARKS, JUST LIKE PEOPLE, HAVE DIVERSE BODY TYPES AND FEATURES
Some sharks are like dogs; others are more similar to sloths. Some have whiskers on their faces (manta rays) and others have 200+ teeth! (great white sharks). Some have 5 rows of teeth (hammerhead sharks), while others have just one row (tiger sharks).

SHARKS DON'T LIKE THE TASTE OF FOX SKINS OR WEASELS.
Sharks actually have a "taste map" to their potential prey. It's hypothesized that sharks can identify the very "fearful" taste and is why there is a high survival rate of shark victims. The same may go for sea otters (members of seals and weasels) as they have been found in a whale shark's stomach.

SHARKS DO WHATEVER THEY CAN TO STAY ALIVE

Sharks have to eat fish, even when they are whale sharks. However, they can't eat certain types of fish which they swallow whole through their mouths. All 33 whale shark species' mouths have a layer lined with oil and in this manner up to 90% of whale body weight.


SHARKS HAPPIER AFTER AGGRESSIVE MATING

The most obvious physical difference between a male and female shark is the presence of testes. This pair of advantages is used for intense fertilization in an effort to ensure population. Male will force the female to hold up to 100% more sperm. If this the female has produced a much thicker skin than males, she resists. When she comes to this point, after the couple sinks down to the bottom floor, coitus ensues and refines.


SHARKS NEED US




