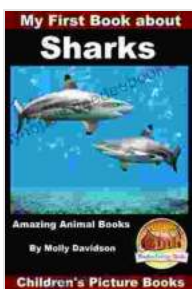

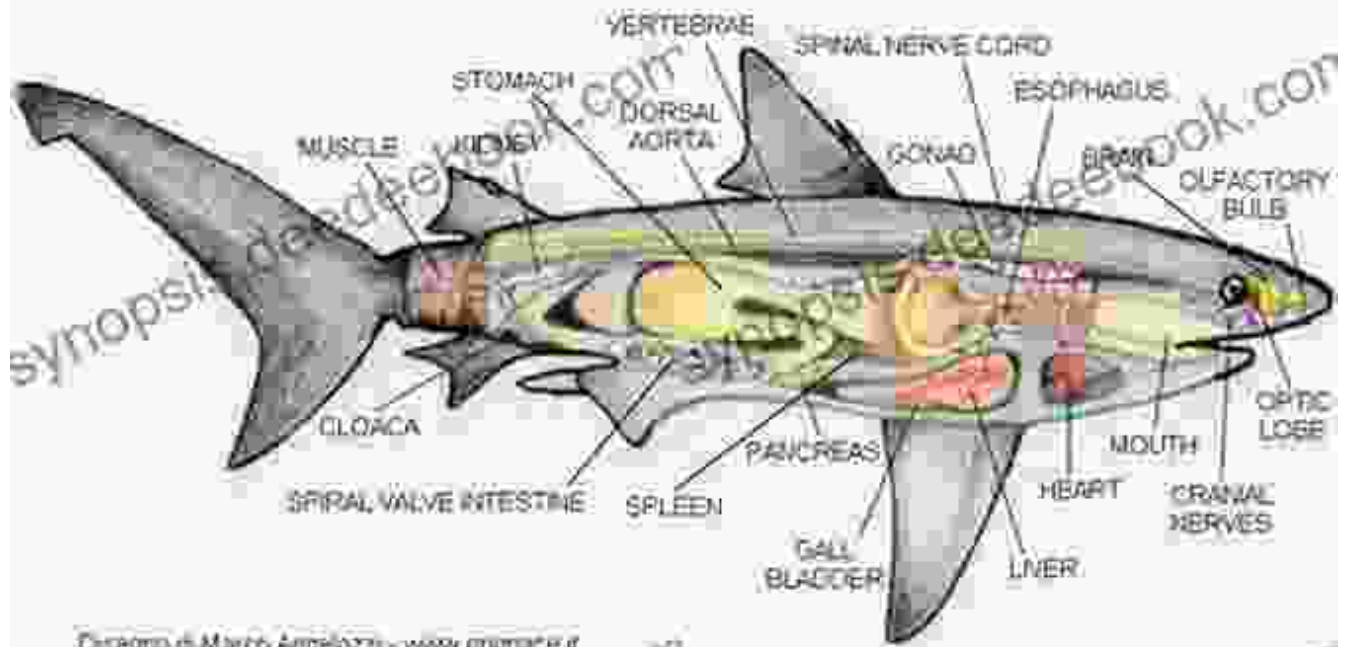




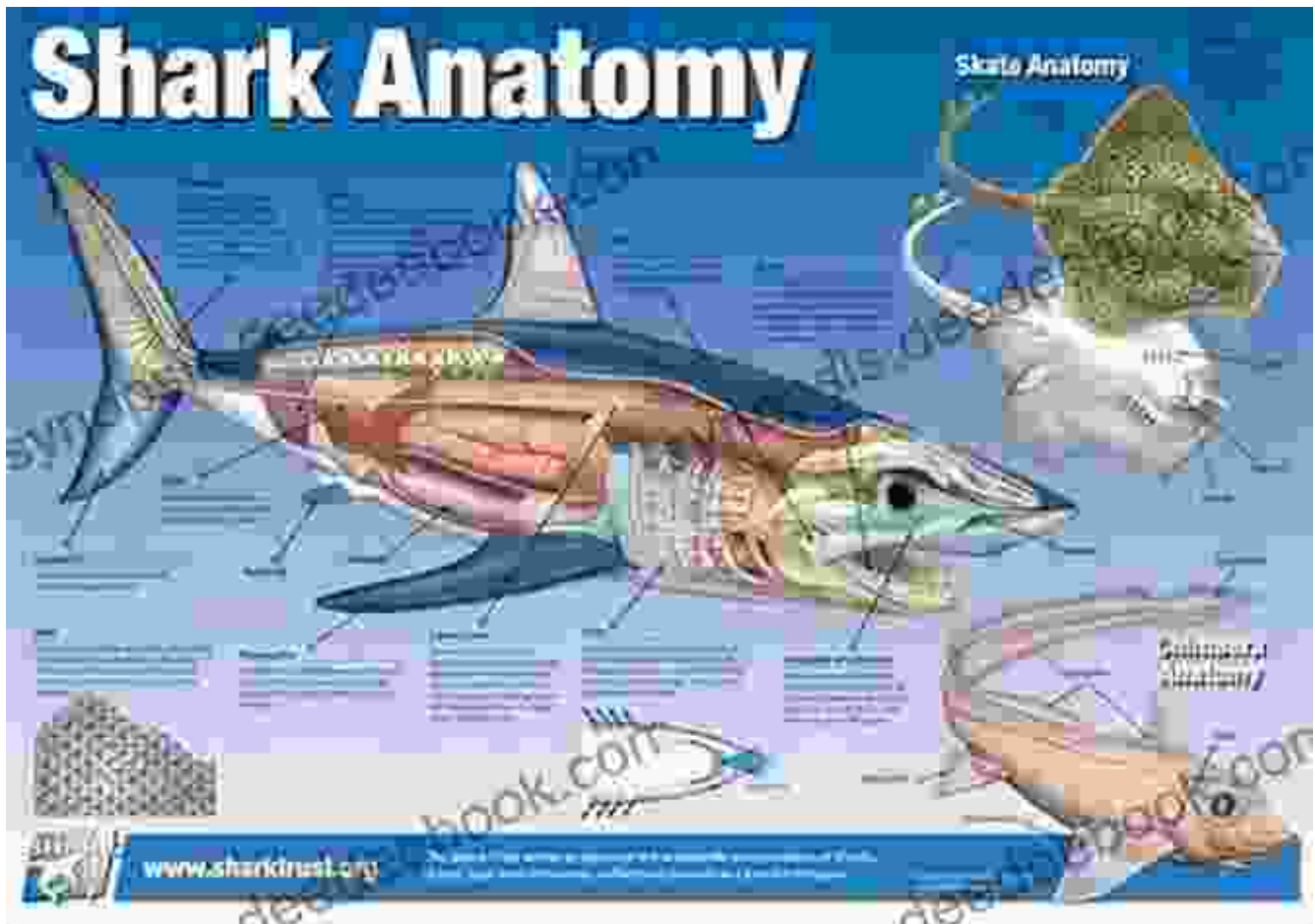
Amazing Shark Features

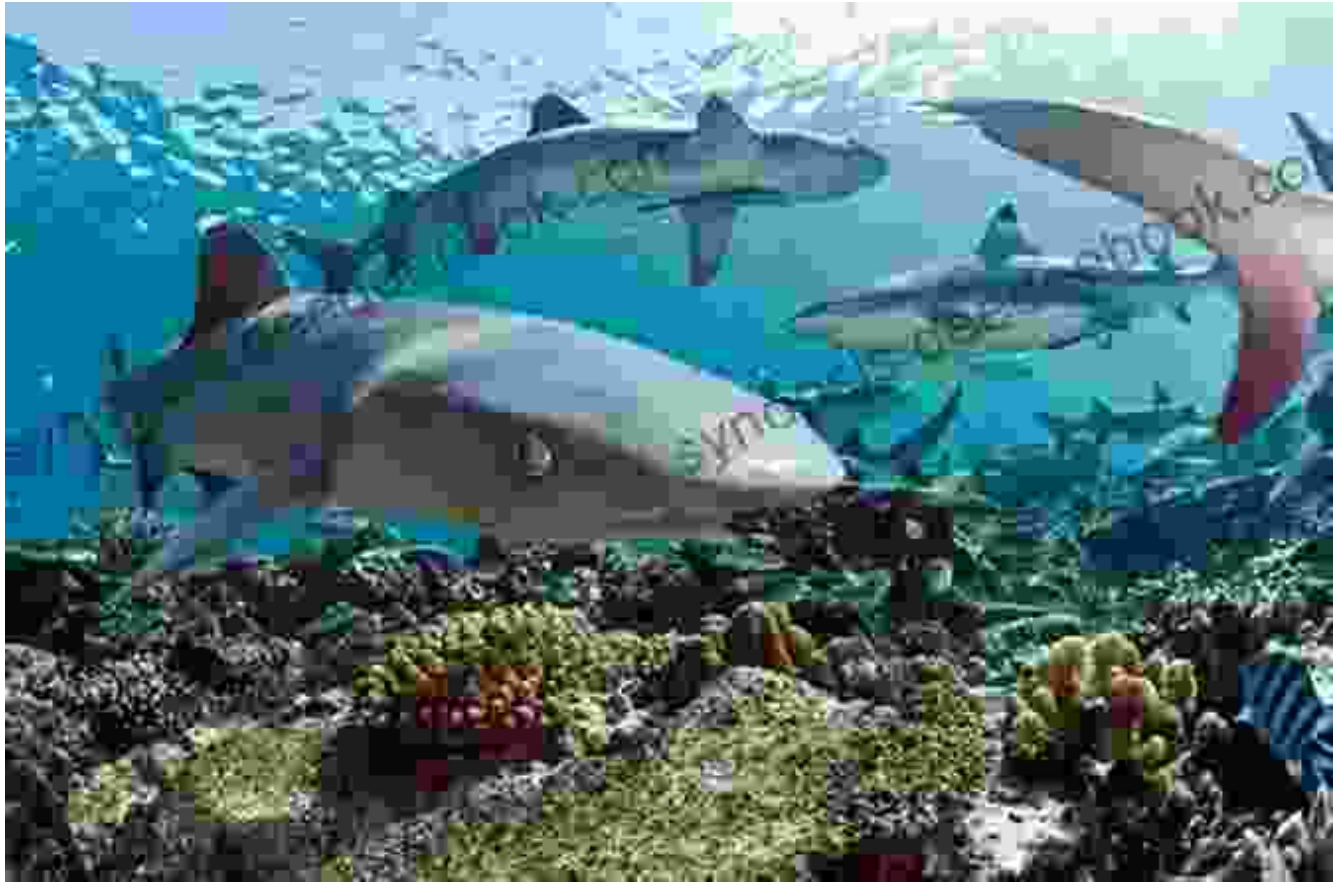

FUN FACTS About Sharks

SHARKS DON'T LIKE PEOPLE, HAVE DIVERSE BODY TYPES & FEATURES
Sharks don't all look alike (whale sharks or striped young like the shark). Some have baskets on their face (manta rays) or very large heads (megalodon sharks). Some glow in the dark (lucifer sharks) or have six eyes (dogfish shark).

SHARKS DON'T LIKE THE TASTE OF YOUR SKIN OR WEASELS
Sharks generally don't eat humans. It's hypothesized that sharks don't like the way humans taste and is why there is a high survival rate of shark victims. The same must go for sea otters (prey of sharks and weasels) as they have never been found in a whale shark's stomach.

SHARKS DO WHATEVER THEY CAN TO STAY ALIVE
Sharks don't breathe over their gills while swimming. However, they can breathe air which they'll swallow air through their mouths. Also, a shark's liver is covered in oil which has a mass of 10% of its body weight.

SHARKS NAP AFTER AGGRESSIVE MATING
The most obvious physical difference between a male and female shark is the presence of claspers. This pair of appendages is used for internal fertilization. In an effort to ensure copulation males will bite the female to hold on for leverage. What's bizarre is that the females have evolved a much thicker skin than males to protect themselves during this ritual. After the couple works down to the sandy floor to rejuvenate and rest.

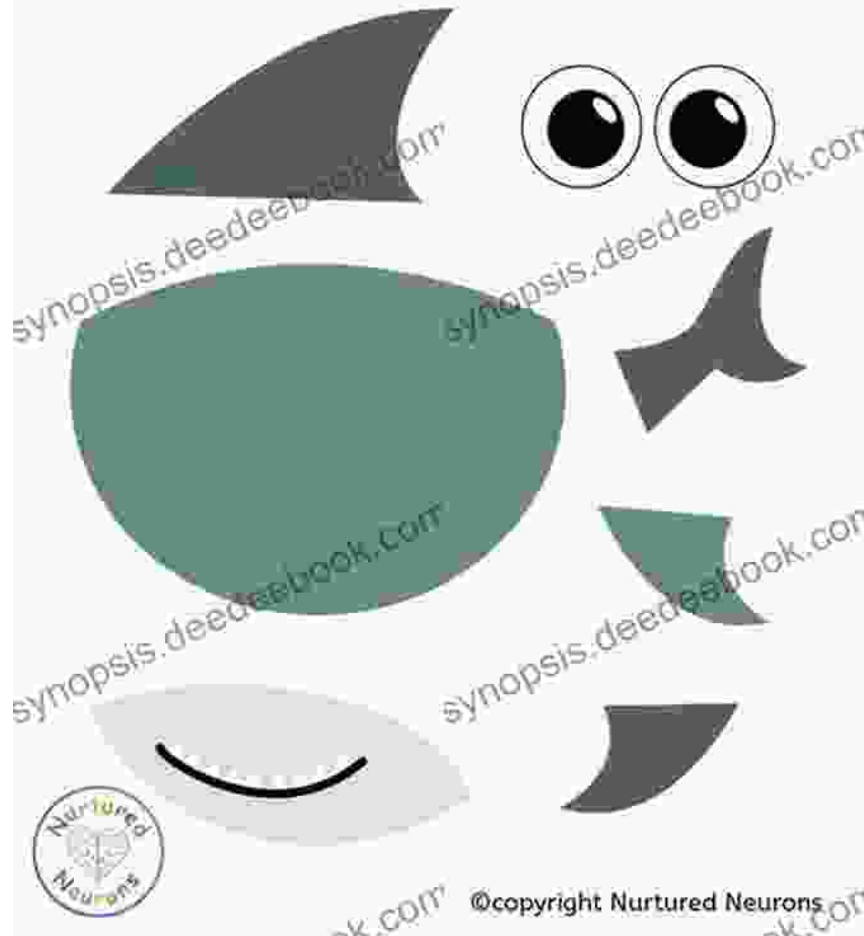
