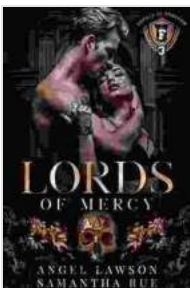

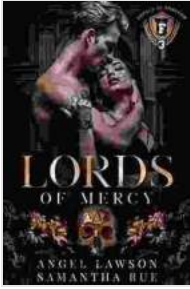
The College of Law is one of the most respected law schools in North Carolina. The college offers a three-year Juris Doctor (J.D.) degree program, as well as a Master of Laws

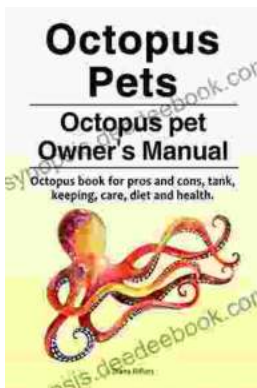

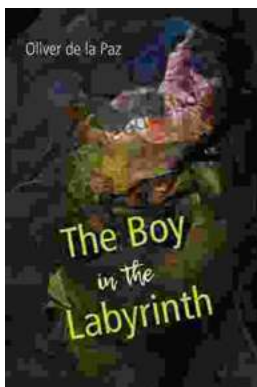
